better known as Q is a survivor of the Liberian Civil War, artist, activist and Executive Direct/Co-Founder of Save More Kids, Inc. A non-profit organization dedicated to empowering young people in Liberia to ultimately help in rebuilding a once beautiful country left in devastation due to the war.

Q wrote *Witness*, to take readers through his childhood experience as a boy confronted with the bloodshed and chaos of war-torn Liberia. After escaping to the US through the strength and fortitude of his mother, Q adapted to American life, completed an undergraduate degree from Savannah College of Art & Design (SCAD) and a Masters of Fine Arts Degree at East Tennessee State University (ETSU).

As an adult, Q returned to his native Liberia to help his mother fulfill her promise to God of adopting orphaned children. Renewed with a sense of purpose and a mission greater than himself, Q and his Wife, Wendy, formed Save More Kids to provide resources and create opportunities for the forgotten children of post-war Liberia.
